

Cricket Rolls Out New Family, iPhone Plans

Prepaid carrier Cricket today announced a new family plan discount, as well as a revamp of plans for the iPhone.

As part of the family plan discount, consumers will essentially get \$10 off the \$50 smartphone plan when they activate 2 lines. The \$50 smartphone plan includes 1GB of data, unlimited talk and text, as well as access to the company's Muve Music service.

The family plan discount is only available on the \$50 plan.

Meanwhile, iPhone users can now change to any of the company's smartphone plans, which start at \$50 and range up to \$70 for 5GB of data, unlimited talk and text, as well as the Muve Music service.

Cricket says that customers on the current \$55 iPhone plan may continue on that plan for as long as they keep their service activated. Customers who would like to change from their current iPhone plan may do so without being charged any fees, unless they wish to upgrade to a new iPhone.

Cricket currently carries the iPhone 4, iPhone 4S and the iPhone 5.
