Anritsu Company has developed the PTCRB-approved protocol test case for IMS Emergency Services. The test case is now available on the ME7834L Protocol Conformance Test (PCT) and Carrier Acceptance Test (CAT) system. Anritsu said it recently became the only supplier of approved test cases for this increasingly relevant technology during the PVG#64 meeting held in Beijing.
