

Verizon Opens More Everything for Month-to-Month Customers

Verizon today [announced](#) [1] that its existing month-to-month customers can now move to the carrier's More Everything plans beginning April 17.

Verizon is promising savings of \$10 for plans with 8 GB and lower and \$25 for plans with 10 GB or more. The carrier will also now allow customers to add phones they already own to a More Everything plan for either \$15 or \$30 per month, depending on the data allowance selected.

Verizon said this offer is good for a limited time but it doesn't specify when the promotion will end.

Verizon [introduced](#) [2] its More Everything plans in February. In some instances, the new plans double the amount of data available previously. Verizon updated More Everything to match AT&T's current offer of four lines with 10 GB of data for \$160.
