Sprint today announced the \$15 International Connect: Call & Text add-on. Coupled with the Family Plan, the add-on allows customers to use voice plan minutes to call 65 international destinations, including Canada and Mexico, at no additional charge per-minute. The \$15 add-on also includes unlimited international text from the U.S. to over 180 countries.

Smith Micro Software, Inc. announced a new version of its NetWise intelligent traffic management solution is being offered as an over-the-top (OTT) smartphone application for both Android and iOS devices. NetWise SmartSpot 3.0 acts as a Wi-Fi concierge, providing a way for end users to locate, prioritize and connect to Wi-Fi access points.
