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**T-Mobile** is now taking online pre-orders for the **Samsung** Galaxy Note 10.1 - 2014 Edition. It will be available for immediate purchase online and in participating retail stores nationwide beginning June 4 for \$99.99 down (and 24 monthly payments of \$23 on T-Mobile's Equipment Installment Plan). Beginning May 30, T-Mobile will offer the new limited edition Samsung Galaxy S 5 in metallic gold for a limited time in select T-Mobile retail stores and online at T-Mobile.com.

**Huawei** today announced the appointment of Ming He as Country General Manager of its operations in the United States.
